**Special Instructions**

1. Violation of any of the below Special Instructions will result in removal from the facility and possible loss of privileges.
2. Area will not be used for testing of model aircraft for commercial or private venture purposes.
3. User will keep area free of any debris, trash and litter resulting from use of area.
4. Parking of vehicles will be allowed on licensed area (Southern portion of Horno LZ Pad) or in designated parking areas in the 53 (Horno) Area. Parking will not be allowed alongside the access road to the Horno LZ Pad.
5. CONEX Box is authorized at grid 55452 93689 (See attached Graphic).
6. Other than active duty military, all members of the Joint Military R/C Flyers Club must also be members of the Academy of Model Aeronautics, Incorporated (AMA).
7. Each member flying a aircraft will have his/her AMA and club card in their possession.
8. LZ may be scheduled no earlier that 48 hours prior to the event:
  - (1) Electric Engines – Between 0600 and a minimum of one hour prior to sunset on Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal Holidays.
  - (2) Gas Engines - Between 0800 and a minimum of one hour prior to sunset on Saturdays, Sundays, and Federal Holidays.
  - (3) Additional days and time can be requested from Range Scheduling no earlier that 48 hours prior to the event. Same day request will not be approved.
  - (4) Requests will be disapproved it any conflicts are present with either Air Field Hours or Ground Operations.
9. User (R/C Flyer) must establish and maintain communications with Camp Pendleton Range Control, (760) 725-3974, at all times. User will provide Range Control with a cell phone number for call back.
10. Operations of the JOINT Military R/C Flyers Club must be restricted to the confines of the R/C ACA – 55030 93993 to 56028 93529 to 55313 94540 to 56193 93822 remaining at or below 750 feet AGL.
11. In the event of a downed R/C Aircraft, user will notify Range Control. At no time will anyone enter the impact area to recover an aircraft (See attached Graphic).
12. Flight operations of the Joint Military R/C Flyers Club must be conducted in accordance with FAA Circular 91-57 and American Aeronautics Association Safety Code.
13. Contact Range Control at (760)725-3974 immediately in the event of any incident.
14. User (R/C Flyer) will establish an "Air Sentry". At anytime aircraft are observed within 2 km, all R/C aircraft will immediately land.
